## Forming Questions

Forming a question in German is just like forming a question in English. There are two types of questions. The first is a specific question. That means that you are asking for a specific piece of information.

These questions begin with a question word (interrogative) and than the verb is second.

```
What is your name?
Where do you live?
Who are you?
When does school start?
How do you get to school?
```

In German, the question words are
Was (What)
Wo (Where)
Wer(Who)
Wann(When)
Wie (How)

So far we can ask:

Wie heißt du? Wie heißt das Mädchen? Wie heißt der Mann?

Pat attention to how the question is formed!

Notice that the question word comes first and the verb follows it!

The second type of question is a general question. They are also called yes or no questions!

This means that you can answer the question with a yes or a no.

Heißt du Jens? Heißt du Frau Kammann?

Both of these questions can be answer with a ja (yes) or a nein (no).

\*Notice that both of the questions are formed by putting the verb first and the subject second. (This is called inverted word order.)
